He instructed TDO to prepare database of Govt. officers from various departments of Ahmedabad Jilla Panchyat and provide to GTU.

As per the instruction of DDO to TDO, Sarpanch, Talati and GTU members to make a team and the same should be informed to health, education and other concerned department.

As discussed in the meeting the progress of the work will be analyzed and evaluate by himself with his another subject expert team members and GTU subject experts.

It is decided in the meeting that the next meeting of the same type will be held in his office on 19-11-2012 at 11.30 am .For this meeting all nodal officers, TDO Sarpanch, Talati and students jointly will prepare a PPT presentation of the project work till time done by them. He motivated the students by saying that the students are lucky enough to have this type of opportunity to work independently on this level project. He has assured all that he will extend maximum help, cooperation and support to the team to make the project successful in a stipulated time schedule.
